

Terre Haute Torpedoes Swim Club
Guidelines on Reinstatements after Resignations
Effective September 2010

After a vote by the Board at the July 2010 board meeting, effective immediately are the following guidelines for the reinstatement of a swimmer after a written resignation. The following are the criteria in which a reinstatement can occur:

- If a swimmer has resigned(quit in the middle of a season), he/she will only be allowed to be reinstated 1 time during each season.
- The reinstatement fee will be equal to the highest swimming group's monthly dues. This fee will be in addition to the monthly dues for the swimmer's group.

For example: Swimmer is in the Silver Group = \$65 monthly dues
+Reinstatement Fee of the highest swim group at the time = \$80

Total: \$145 to reinstate

The purpose of this policy is to discourage families/swimmers from taking time off in the middle of the season and then requesting credits/reimbursements for their time off, creating a bookkeeping problem for the Club Treasurer and making it very difficult for the Club to operate within its budget.
